Graduation Requirement Part II

Pathway I:

Ohio's State Tests Earn at least 18 points on seven end-of-course state tests.

End of Course Exams: Algebra, Geometry, ELA I, ELA II, Biology, American History, and American Government.

Pathway II:

Industry credential and Workforce readiness

Earn a minimum of 12 points by receiving a State Board of Education-approved, industry-recognized credential or group of credentials in a single career field and earn the required score on WorkKeys, a work-readiness test.

Pathway III:

College and Career Readiness tests

Earn remediation-free scores in mathematics and English language arts on either the ACT or SAT.

ACT Test Remediation Score

- English subscore of **18**
- Reading subscore of **22**
- Mathematics subscore of **22**
